

It's all about democracy



The Danish approach is very general, focusing on building democratic and social skills



Very much in line with EU Paris Declaration (2015) and inspired by the Council of Europe's Competences for <u>Democratic Culture and Intercultural Dialogue</u>



The main purpose is to develop social skills, critical thinking and sense of responsibility in children and young people



Capacity building among professionals in education

Building citizenship and democratic culture in school



School development (capacity building among professional)



Reflecting on personal values and attitudes in relation to citizenship, controversial issues and radicalisation



Becoming aware of blind spots, prejudices and preconceptions



Practicing dialogue, negotiation and conflict transformation in teams and through the whole school organisation



Courage and skills to talk about controversial issues, challenge prejudices, analytical approach to norms, values and habbits

Initiatives – from the ministry

- Strengthening the qualifications in the ministry in order to help municipalities on extremism and radicalisation
- Development of learning materials for the national learning portal
- Education programmes
- Literature review preventing radicalisation in education, school strategies on developing democratic citizenship, critical thinking, controversial issues, preventing marginalisation, cooperation with parents
