In these difficult days, all of us face a challenge that we have not experienced before. The COVID-19 crisis threatens every area of our lives including the field of education.

As in many countries, millions of students in Israel, in kindergartens, elementary schools, and secondary schools are closed in their homes, according to the government's instructions. Educators were asked to close the gates of schools and were required to shift to distance on-line teaching from their homes.

Distance learning is very diverse and includes a wide range of activities including - preparing online lessons, having direct contact with students and parents on all digital media, guiding and directing students in learning processes, conducting exams and assessment routines. Distance learning processes also take place with kindergartens students.

Alongside the great investment and efforts of educational staffs to continue to maintain a learning routine in this time of emergency, we are facing threats of harming our wages and working conditions, and a lack of appreciation for the great investment and dedication that educational staffs are required to in these days.
